## Overview

This document guides you to use the '**RICHWEB**' reference project using DevoSA (Vaakya Rich IDE)

The 'RICH WEB' project is a sample Vaakya application to showcase use of Web 2.0 concepts like Ajax, Json, Flash and other Rich Internet capabilities.

You can view the source code of Vaakya for this application as well as related browser side html / javascript code.

This sample application also gives you a quick feel of the DevoSA (Vaakya Rich IDE) and DevoSA Manager.

## Steps to use


- Download & Unzip respective Zip files
- Folder contains

 RICHWEB.prj (17 KB) - Project Source

 RICHWEB.vuf (807 KB) - Project Data, Static

## Import & View

Use '**RICHWEB.prj**' – to import & view source using DevoSA (Vaakya Rich IDE)

- Install DevoSA (Vaakya Rich IDE) – refer DevoSA Installation Guide
- Copy 'RICHWEB.prj' from the above folder and paste into **VAAKYA/ZONESERVER/DEVOSA/CORPUS/IDES/IMPORT**
- Start Vaakya Zone Server using Zone Manager (Zone Server contains a built-in Http Web Server)
- Launch DevoSA (Vaakya Rich IDE) – Refer DevoSA Guide for help
- Go to IDE Menu → Project → Create
- Type project name as 'RICHWEB' & Click on Save
- Go to IDE Menu → Utilities → Import Project
- Select project 'RICHWEB' (press F1)
- Select File 'RICHWEB.prj' (press F1, click on , select RICHWEB.prj and click on )
- Enter License Key (abcd-efgh-ijkl-mnop)
- Click on 'Import'


## How to Use – RICHWEB App

- Go to IDE Menu → Project → Load Project '**RICHWEB**'
- You can now view source code of the project

## Execute

- Go to IDE Menu → Test Project → Create Executable
- Click 'Select All' option → Click on OK
- To view the application, follow steps below

Use '**RICHWEB.vuf**' – to upload 'vuf' & view RICHWEB application using DevoSA Manager

- Launch DevoSA Manager (Refer DevoSA Guide)
- Open browser and type the URL to launch DevoSA Manager  
http://127.0.0.1:9000/VAAKYA/DEVOSA/CORPUS/STATIC/IDEMANAGER/DEFAULT/index.html
- Select Menu → Upload Vuf
- Select project 'RICHWEB'
- Select domain ' DEFAULT'
- Upload Vuf file 'RICHWEB.vuf' from the above folder
- Enter License Key (abcd-efgh-ijkl-mnop)
- Click on 'Upload' (check "file uploaded successfully" message, if not upload again)
- Go to Menu → Start/Stop Project
- Start 'RICHWEB' project (check status  Project started)
- Click on the project URL to view the application
