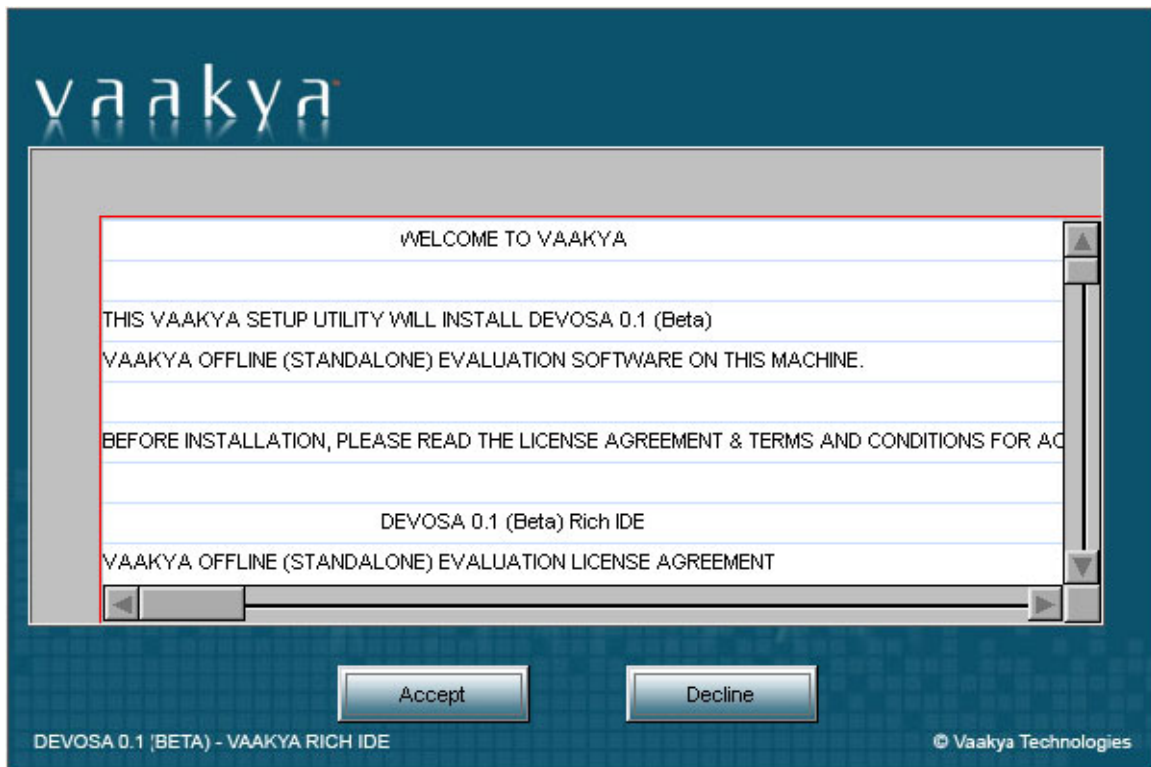

Introduction

This document describes the steps involved in installing the product DevoSA (Beta) – Vaakya Rich IDE.

Installation Steps

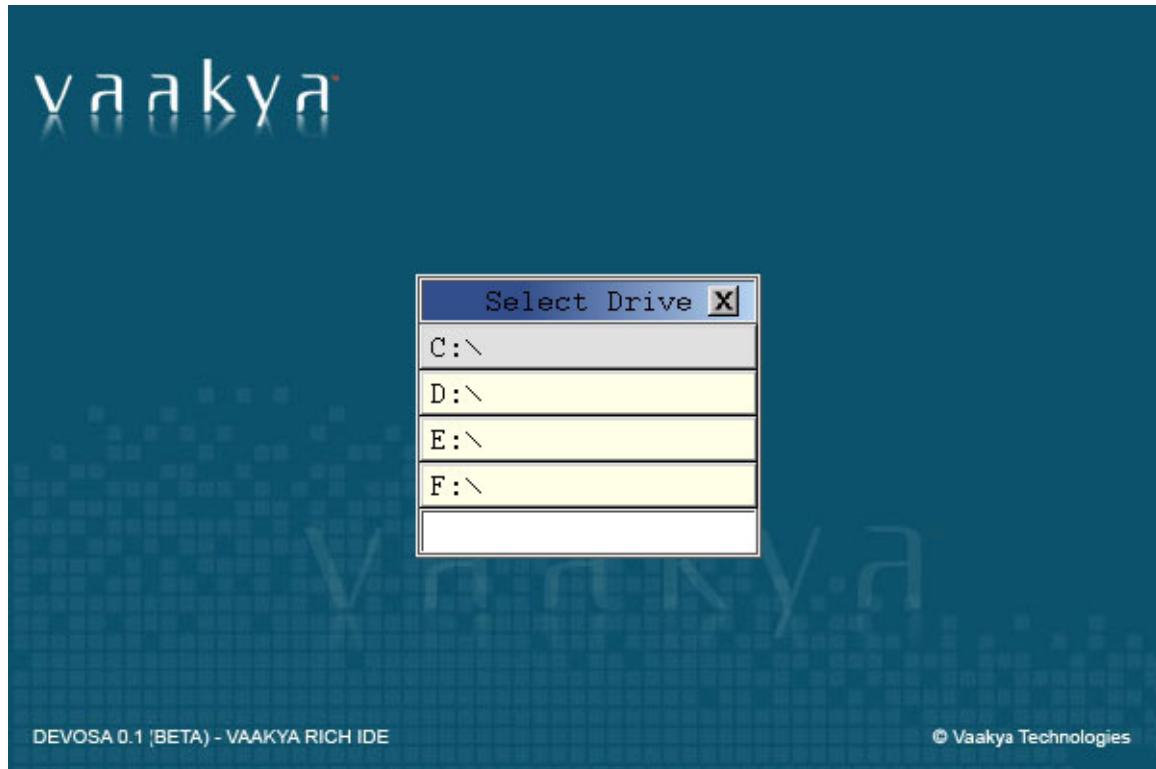
- Download the product - DevoSA 0.1 (Beta).exe from <http://www.vaakya.com>
- Double click to run the product Installer



- Click on 'Accept' to continue. 'Decline' will exit the installation process.

New Installation

- From the Popup list, choose the drive to install Vaakya DevoSA.



Re-Installation

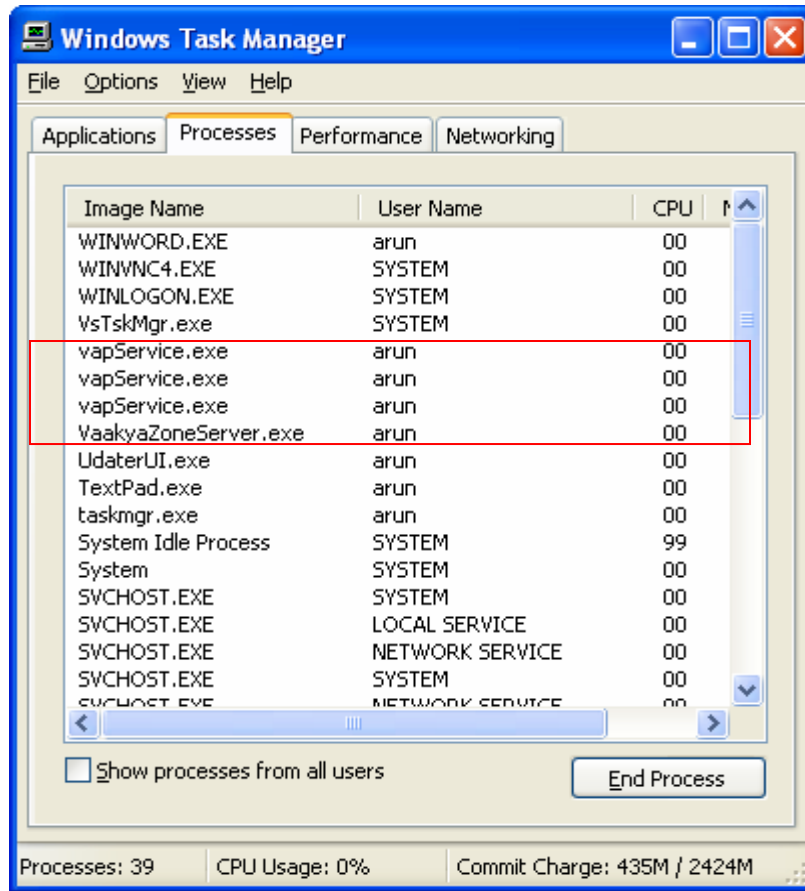
Note:

If this product is already installed in your system and used, related Vaakya application services may be running in your system.

Please stop the services to re-install again.

To Stop,

- **Go to Vaakya Zone Manager and Stop Zone Server**
- Else, Go to Task Manager, and stop the following processes:
 - VaakyaZoneServer.exe (End Process Tree)
 - vapService.exe (Stop all vapService.exe process related to the product)



- If this product is already installed in your system, a message “Do you wish to overwrite” will be prompted.

- Click 'Yes' to proceed or 'No' to Exit the installer. (Read the **Note** above before you wish to re-install / overwrite the product)
- Before overwriting the product, please take a backup (use Pack for Development of DevoSA) of the projects created earlier. After re-installation, create the project names in the IDE again and copy the projects from backup to proceed.
- On completion of installation, the following message will be displayed. Click on 'Finish' to complete the process.



Launch DevoSA

On successful installation, shortcuts for Vaakya Zone Manager and DevoSA will be created on your desktop.
