Overview

Vaakya Zone Manager (**VZM**) is a utility application to manage Vaakya Zone Server and related Vaakya application services. This document explains in brief various functionalities available in **VZM**.

Vaakya Zone Server

Vaakya Zone Server is a multiple protocol control server (with a built in http web server), which is used to manage various Vaakya application services identified as "**vapservice**".

It is essential to run Vaakya Zone Server before using Vaakya products / services

Configure Vaakya Zone Server

Let us configure the Vaakya Zone Server

- Open the file 'zone.cfg' found in \VAAKYA\ZONESERVER\ zone.cfg
- Default IP set is 127.0.0.1.
- If your system is behind a network, use appropriate IP assigned
- Change IP according to your settings. Otherwise continue with the default IP
- `<config key="SystemIp" value="127.0.0.1"/>`
- Configure VaakyaZoneServer Port.
 - `<key VAPZONE_Port="8000"/>`
(This is the Port on which the VaakyaZoneServer runs. If 8000 is not free, use any other port)
- Configure Http Listener Port for Vaakya Zone Server
- **Option (i)** If port 80 is not free, (use default setting 9000 or any other port)
 - `<key VAPZONE_HttpPort="9000"/>`
- Or, **Option (ii)** If port 80 is free, use
 - `<key VAPZONE_HttpPort="80"/>`

Launch Vaakya Zone Manager (VZM)

- Double click on the Vaakya Zone Manager desktop shortcut icon.



Start Zone Server

- Click on 'Start Zone Server' to launch Vaakya Zone Server



Note

Vaakya Zone Server has to be started first before using Vaakya DevoSA product or DevoSA Manager

Stop Zone Server

- Click 'Stop Zone Server' to stop Vaakya Zone Server and related Vaakya application services (vapservices).



Note

Stopping Vaakya Zone Server will stop all Vaakya application services (vapservice.exe)

Close Zone Manager

- Use this option to close the GUI of Vaakya Zone Manager

Note

Closing the Vaakya Zone Manager **will not** terminate the Vaakya Zone Server and related application services
